Holy Spirit Hospital in East Pennsboro Twp. Offers two types of alcohol rehabilitation treatment options, inpatient and outpatient. With all options, counselors recommend patients attend Alcoholics Anonymous meetings:

Inpatient rehab: Length of stay varies depending on patient's progress and the managed-care provider. Treatment can be arranged with the assistance of hospital personnel or with the assistance of a managed-care provider.

Intensive outpatient treatment: Patients attend counseling several days a week, usually in group therapy and education.

Outpatient treatment: Patients have weekly individual counseling with a therapist. Patients might also attend group therapy.
