Don't want to use 2 separate banks.
 - Chelsea defined Prudent Reserves something that is determined by the group that we voted on at one point for 3 months of operating expenses in our bylaws can be 1-3 months advised that Treasurer is our trusted servant and we will trust her decision. Reminded we need to be careful how much money is in there and don't want to have too much. Might need to discuss that that amount is again and what is needed.
 - More discussion around accounts & budgets: Budget is a proposed budget only big change is the accessibilities – will meet next week and discuss next month when we have the actual numbers
