The flat screen can be mounted on the wall to be used for workshops, district purposes, etc. Josh reviewed Tradition 7. If we are to be guardians of the tradition, we cannot be influenced by a kind act that should be reimbursed. Marie reminded us of "principles before personalities." We should have voted before the expense. **Norm motioned to reimburse Jose for the purchase. Group conscious discussion included the fact that Autumn is in her 11<sup>th</sup> month of sobriety; typically 2 years sobriety is needed. Dwight motioned to waive the sobriety requirement in this situation especially since at the end of Joe B's tenure, Autumn will have required amount of sobriety. Dwight motioned to accept Autumn's nomination; Neil seconded. 12 votes in favor; Autumn accepted.
