#### **Old Business:**

Rebellion Dogs made a motion to purchase 1,000 Daily Meditation Books to hand out at AA meetings like we do with meetings in a pocket. Opened back up for discussion on 8/7/2025. Travis has new information: Suggested typing up the daily meditations ourselves and printing them out ourselves for homegroups or members to purchase. Travis suggested charging .10 cents per copy. Monique suggested that we get in contact with someone from SEPIA to see how the meditation books are made rather than making them ourselves. Chris B. made a suggestion to amend the motion. Travis made a motion to amend the motion. Passed. Travis made a motion that our literature chair adds daily meditation books to our literature. Vote passed.

AA Liaison position for Al-Anon meetings. Opened back up for discussion on 8/7/25: Hannah made a motion for the position to be created. Vote passed for creating an AA liaison for Al-Anon meetings. In September we will be taking votes for this open position, please bring this to your homegroups.

#### **New Business:**

Rebellion Dogs brought to attention that there are no set term limits for sub-committee chair positions in by-laws. Made a motion that sub-committee commitments are to be held for 2 years maximum. Honoring the spirit of rotation. Travis is the chair of the sub-committee that will be reviewing this motion and updating the by-laws.

Chris B. made a motion that our treasurer and finance committee look into an umbrella bank account. Each committee would have their own treasurer and projected budget for the year. It would be the same account but they would have their own individual within. It allows committees to operate more smoothly and is easier to track. Each treasurer from the sub-committee would submit to the HAI treasurer and will be more transparent and accessible in the monthly HAI treasurer report. Erik K. would like to stand for PI Chair. Tabled until September meeting.

Nicole P made a motion that sub-committee members be held accountable to show up to Intergroup to give reports, this will need updated in by-laws and will be worked on in Travis's sub-committee for updating by-laws as talked about above. Motion passed.

Chris B. made a motion to disband the activities committee and reform under the HAI. Motion tabled until September HAI meeting.

Question 11: HAI observes the spirit of rotation in service positions

Overall, the answer was no for both: **Some things we have said:** I see the same reps repeatedly for multiple years on end. Having more diversity and attendance would be beneficial. Some people have positions for a very long time or hold multiple positions. We don't follow spirit of rotation.

**Suggestions for 11:** A position does not need to be filled; it can be vacant. New people bring new ideas. Deprives others of service opportunities.

Question 12: HAI Monthly Meeting (Fellowship House) is acceptable

Overall, the answer was even for Both: **Some things we have said**: This is becoming an issue with afflictions made between AA and the Fellowship house building regarding money, responsibility and conflicts of interest. More than Acceptable. It makes geographic sense. It does seclude some further reaching rural areas. It affiliates HAI with a non-AA organization, even if it is in the spirit of recovery, it violates traditions. People think the clubhouse is AA owned and operated. Fellowship house is the defacto service center for the region. If we look at HAI as a whole it is not centralized.

**Suggestions for 12:** Where do other intergroups meet? May want to form an ad hoc to research.
