
- A. Attended the Dauphin County Prison Board Meeting on 1/14/2026.

## Notes from Dauphin County Prison Board Meeting (1/14/2026)

### Prison Board Chair's Report:

- Enhanced meals for the holidays
- Holiday care packets were distributed by Christian Church United
- Director of Criminal Justice John Bey (hired in Feb. 2023) took new role as Director of Juvenile Probation effective 1/2/2026.
  - From news sources: "Bey is the first person to hold the position of criminal justice director for Dauphin County, a job designed to address transparency and accountability issues."

### New Chair's welcome speech included the following talking points:

- Primary focus is on healthcare of staff and inmates
- Looking forward to working with the new medical provider (Medico) for better healthcare for staff and inmates
- More transparency within the prison and Correction Officers (COs)
- Hire new COs to help with staffing issues and more transparency against contraband
- Inmate deaths referred to as unfortunate events
- Prevent inmates from using iPads to light things on fire

### Medical Report

- Medico is the new prison medical provider (Kevin, RN) reported 265 intakes in December with 92 suicide attempts and 69 mental health calls
- DCP Medical Concerns Group was formed

### Operations Report (from Deputy Warden)

- 6,000 E-books have been issued

### Treatment Report

- 7 Treatment Specialist vacancies
- 2 Chaplains being onboarded
- 131 initial classifications
- 1 student received their GED
- 11 moved to work release
- 35 re-entry plans
- 9 inpatient referrals for drug/alcohol
- 2 mental health inpatient referrals

### Wardens Report

- Prison population is 685 males, 83 females
- Work Release population is 100 men, 23 women
- 6 new COs were hired 1/5/2026
- 18 CO vacancies

### Criminal Justice Advisory Board

- Cost of communications. How and what can be changed for phone calls
